Jazz Jam - March 22nd

OK Tammany music lovers mark your calendar for March 22 Saturday night 7:30 to 10:30. "Redoux" is going to bring five of their players along with a couple of singers to give us a great dance night. There slogan is "we play the music you remember". There song list consists of tunes from the 40's through the 90's and includes hit songs with Blues, Jazz, Rock and Country formats.

Their drummer is Don Carr. Like most of them, Don has played in bands since he was a kid. Cindi King provides most of the lead vocals as well as saxophone, Ly Derigo keeps the beat alive with his super bass playing, Guitarist, Teddy Scott is featured on many vocals and melody guitar riffs. And finally, Bob Montgomery is the other guitarist and plays many of the Blues, Country and Rock guitar solos.

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Makes 19" deep dish pie

Prep time 30 minutes, Cook time 55 minutes at 375 degrees

2 Pepperidge Farm or Mrs. Smith's Frozen Deep Dish Pie crusts (come 2 in a package, thawed in refrigerator) or a homemade crust of course!

1 Pre-cooked complete chicken breast or equivalent amount of meat (rotisserie with skin for flavor, is easiest about 2-3 cups)

2-3 cloves of garlic chopped (optional)

1 cup chopped onion

2-3 tablespoons butter

2-3 tablespoons olive oil

1/4 cup flour

1 standard can chicken broth or stock

1 chicken bouillon cube

1 cup frozen peas

1 cup chopped carrots

(or substitute 2 cups frozen vegetable mix for peas and carrots)

½ bag frozen pearl onions

2 tablespoons chopped parsley, fresh or dried

1- 2 teaspoons Season Salt of your choice

2-3 tablespoons heavy cream, I have substituted sour cream in a pinch.

1 egg (for egg wash)

Sea or kosher salt for crust

Hint: Taste before adjusting salt and pepper to taste

Preheat oven to 375.

Take one thawed crust out of shell and flatten by rolling slightly with rolling pen or with hands, seal any cracks as this will be the top crust. Prepare egg wash by lightly beating one egg with 1 tablespoon heavy cream

Melt butter and olive oil together in a large sauce pan, add onions and sauté until translucent, add garlic and sauté a minute longer, add flour and stir well for a few minutes, add stock or broth, chicken, bouillon, parsley, and vegetables, stir all together. Test for salt content as salt in stocks and bouillon can vary greatly. Add season salt and pepper to taste. Bring all ingredients up to heat. You can add up to a soup can of water to desired consistency. (Cooked consistency will be about the same as pre-cooked consistency, it will thicken when cooled.) Fill bottom crust, you can "heap" it some if it is thick, but if it is thinner be careful not to over fill. Place top crust on top and crimp edges. Brush top with egg wash and sprinkle with salt and pepper, cut a few vents to allow steam to escape. Bake at 375 degrees in the center of oven on a cookie sheet if you are concerned about spillage, about 55 minutes or until golden brown.

The phone numbers are in the directory, so if at all possible, please don't save it up for when we trying to enjoy the club.

In an effort to provide a bit more return for the members as well as seeking to improve attendance, the board has approved half priced drinks from 5 to 7 PM on Saturdays. When there is a TYC event such as the crawfish boil this will not apply, and the Thursday second drink free is not affected. Note the Saturday pricing is half price for all drinks from 5 to 7. 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
